Sub : 3rd Triennial General Body Conference of FOBOIPARA, our affiliate in Bank of India takes place at Ahmedabad on 26th & 27th November, in the midst of tremendous enthusiasm and participative involvement of retirees as well as serving brethren.

We have much pleasure to inform our membership that one of our strongest affiliates in the country presented a gallant show and made it a moment of pride for all of us. The highlights of the conference are mentioned hereunder :

- The host team of Gujrat led by Com. R.S. Trivedi, Com. Dilip Raval, Com. N.R. Dabhi and Com. P.S. Jadeja left no stone unturned to make the occasion a grand festivity.
- The inaugural conference was addressed among others by Com. K.V. Acharya, President, AIBPARC and Joint Convenor of CBPRO, Shri M.K. Gupta, General Manager, Bank of India, Com. Suresh Rindani, the Vetrean Trade Union Leader and Com. P.S. Patki, General Secretary, FOBOIPARA. Com. Acharya in his key note address narrated the initiatives undertaken by CBPRO/AIBPARC in highlighting the issues of bank retirees in all possible corners of the country as well as the corridors of power. He observed that the joint struggle of CBPRO and AIBRF would go many more miles to come and appealed to members to take part actively at the joint programmes of demonstration cum dharna. Shri M.K.
