Sub: Twin landslides cause devastation at Wayanad – the picturesque tourist spot turns into a wasteland – AIBPARC conveys profound shock and anguish.

We are deeply shocked to know the worst natural disaster of Kerala since the great floods of 2018 which has caused large scale havoc at Wayanad. Death, devastation and decay are the apt words to describe the tragedy. As far as newspaper reports go, there have been 126 deaths so far and more than 100 people are missing. As the rescue operation is going on in full swing, the death toll might go up further. The trail of destruction stretched from Mundakkai to Chooralmala. The sleepy valley which attracted thousands of tourists has now turned into a wasteland.

We deeply mourn the tragedy and promise to stand by the side of the suffering humanity. We shall remain in touch with the leaders of the state committee of Kerala and all other senior leaders stationed in the state and we shall also explore all possibilities of how we can help the people in distress within our limited capabilities. We have our silent prayers for the eternal peace of the souls of persons who passed away and we wish that the injured persons will recover early.
